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Getting Ready to Reopen...

Action Chemical would like to offer guidance and direction to help implement a framework for best practices as you start to reopen your businesses.

Prevention



Conduct an Assessment:

- 1. What staff/employees are at high risk?
- 2. Is our business participating in activities that promote transmission?
- 3. Does our business have an existing cleaning procedure? Can it be improved?
- 4. Are there locations where employees typically congregate?
- 5. Are there areas in our business that would not allow customers or staff to distance?

Important Employee Practices:

<u>Wear a Mask:</u> Non –Medical face masks should be worn when the 6ft rule cannot be applied.

Social Distance: Keep employees 6ft apart.

<u>Disinfect and Clean Workspaces:</u> Increase the amount of cleaning and disinfecting, and make sure cleaning supplies are readily available to employees. All offices, bathrooms, common areas and shared equipment should be done routinely.

<u>Work Site Supervisors:</u> Designate a worksite supervisor to monitor control strategies and be present at all times.

Prevention Continued



• Identfy contagious employees, high touch/traffic areas, and high risk employees.

Exclude

• Exclude exposed emloyees, from contact with others and customers.



• Protect employees and customers alike, with extra disinfection precautions, personal protective equipment and social distancing practices.

Administrative Controls



Physical Distancing:

Where possible, keep employees and customers the CDC recommended 6ft distance.

Engineering Controls:

Create physical barriers between people, and designate standing and seating areas.

Administrative Controls:

Redistribute responsibilities to help limit the amount of necessary people.

Personal Protective

Equipment: Have people wear non-medical face coverings.


